- ▶ A way to demonstrate leadership for the benefit of my community




# Where

A permanent pavilion that is 20x30 (600 sq. ft.)


- ▶ Gathering place to keep dry year-round

Before snowmelt

- ▶ Permitting

- ▶ Resource collection

After snowmelt

- ▶ Lay it out
- ▶ Dig holes
- ▶ Work parties for construction
